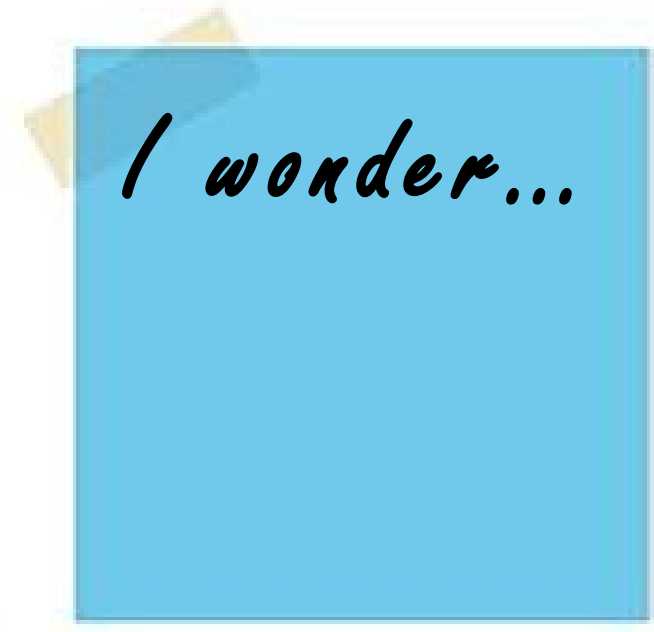

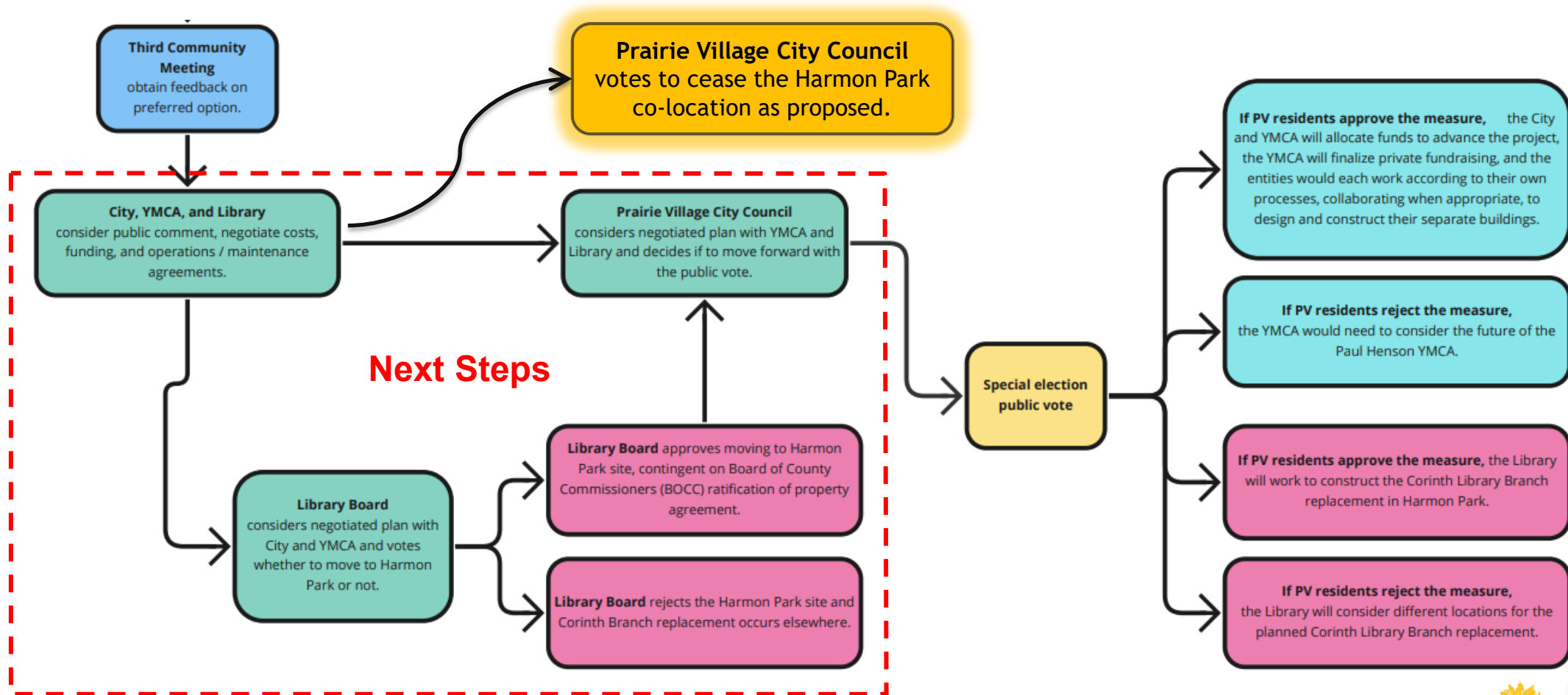


Corinth Replacement Project and Harmon Park co-location site study

Corinth Replacement Project:

Stay and rebuild on current Corinth site

PROS

- location legacy
- high visibility on Mission Rd
- possible occupiable roof
- two-story library (opportunities for iconic architecture and dedicated kids area for acoustics)
- drive-thru path is intuitive and less dominant
- autonomy
 - we already own the property
 - operational autonomy
 - decision & design autonomy
 - dedicated parking

CONS

- two-story library (staffing and patron navigation)
- site development will require earthwork and retaining walls
- existing branch would need to close during construction
- no adjacent park amenities
- site challenges
 - still difficult to make a left turn exit out of parking lot
 - traffic can back up at the exit at peak hours

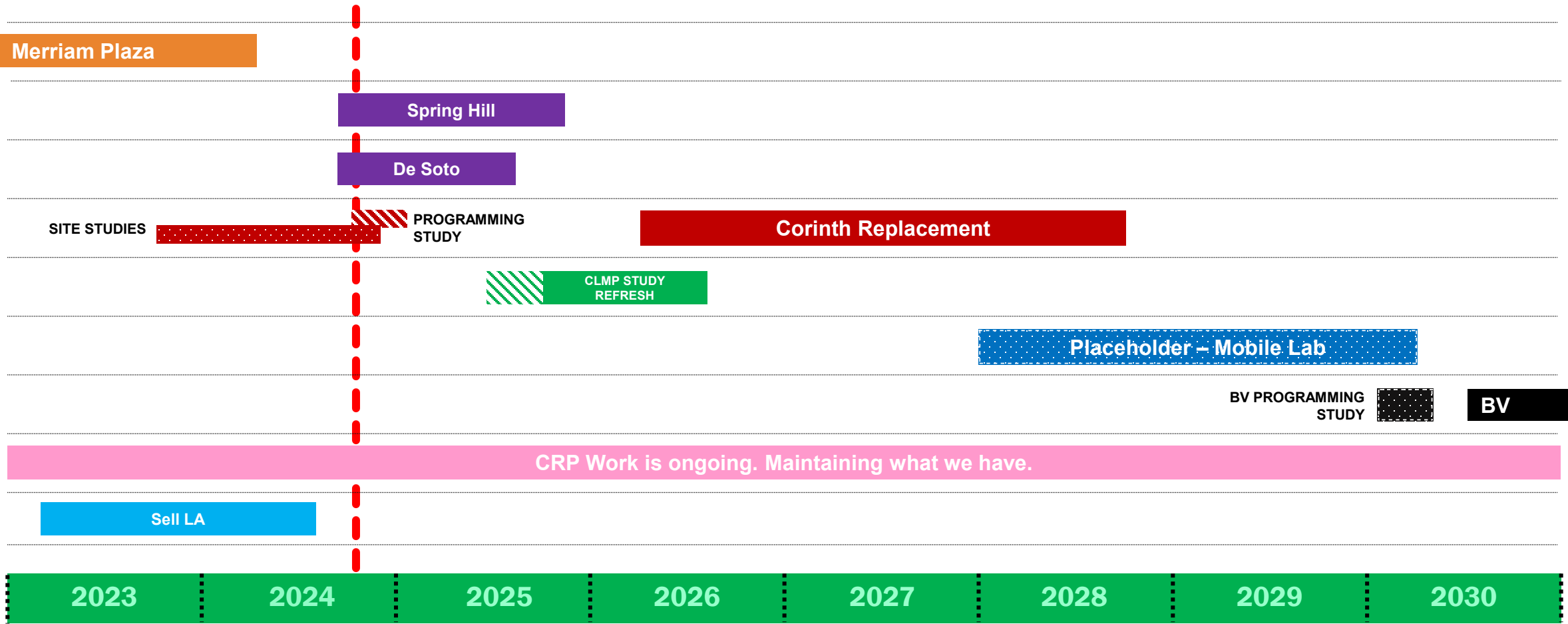
